## MY BUSINESS ACCOUNT - AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE

- Business owners who are already registered for My Account do not have to register again for My Business Account. They can sign in to My Business Account using their CRA user ID and password.
- If you don't have a CRA user ID and password, you'll need to create one and for this, you'll need your:
  - Social insurance number
  - Date of birth
  - Current postal or zip code
  - Personal income tax returns from the current and previous year
  - Business number
- Once you have signed up for My Business Account, you will need to add your business number to your account.
   You will only be allowed to do this if your name and social insurance number matches the information the CRA has on file for the business. If you get an error message at this step, you will need to contact the CRA to update their records.
